

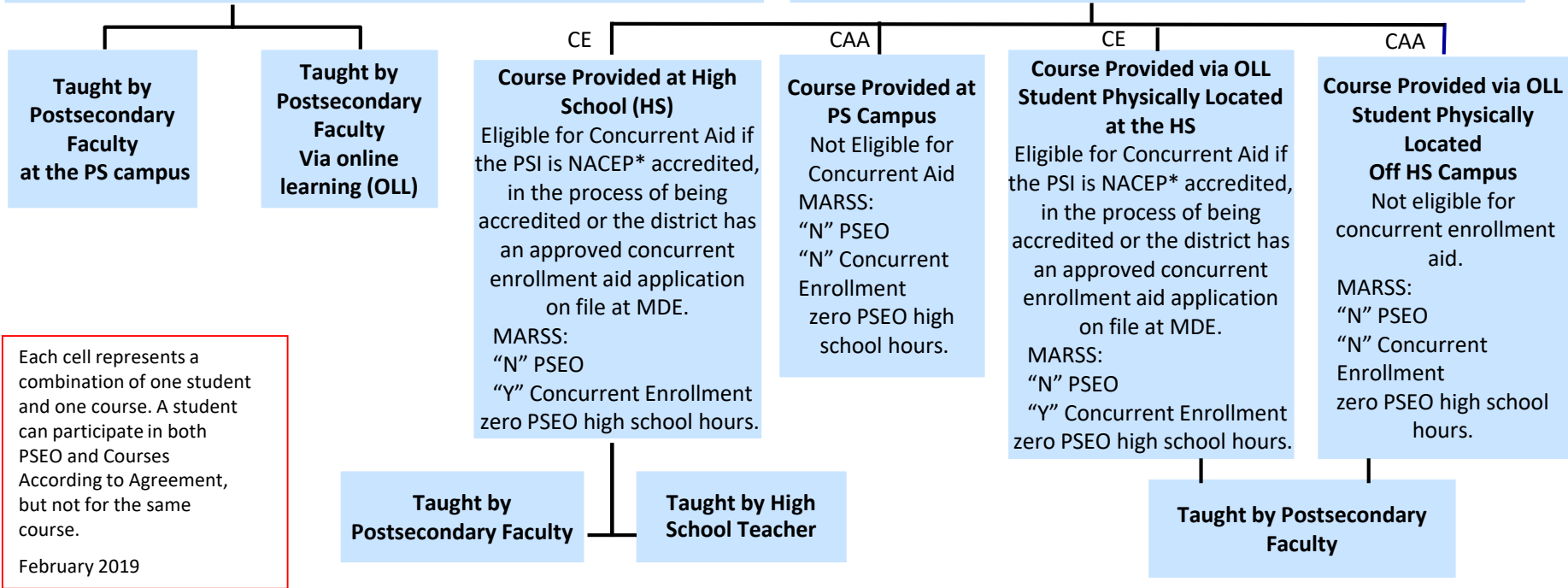
**Postsecondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) (M.S. § 124D.09)**  
 Both juniors and seniors earn high school and postsecondary credit at state-approved postsecondary institutions (PSIs). In some circumstances, freshman and sophomore students earn high school and postsecondary credit at state-approved PSIs.

**PSEO Programs Include:**

- PSEO
- Courses According to Agreement (CAA)
- Concurrent Enrollment (CE)
  - College in the Schools

**Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) Pays Tuition**  
 MARSS (Minnesota Automated Reporting Student System):  
 “Y” PSEO - PSEO high school hours needed and it excludes study hall  
 “N” Concurrent Enrollment  
 PSI determines which juniors and seniors are eligible to participate and in which/how many postsecondary (PS) courses.  
 Sophomore students are eligible to participate in a career and technical class.

**Courses According to Agreement/ District Pays Tuition**  
 MARSS:  
 “N” PSEO – zero PSEO high school hours  
 District and PSI together determine which juniors and seniors are eligible to participate and in which/how many PS courses. Freshman and sophomore students are eligible to participate in certain circumstances.



Each cell represents a combination of one student and one course. A student can participate in both PSEO and Courses According to Agreement, but not for the same course.
