



General Timeline of Events

You will find below a general calendar of events for the State Fiscal Year 2020 (SFY20) and State Fiscal Year 2021 (SFY21). If you are a current grantee, please follow your reporting schedule as outlined in the Official Grant Award Notification (OGAN).

State Fiscal Year 2020 (SFY20)

SFY20 runs from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020

- July 1, 2019 – Beginning of SFY20, which is the start of the biennium
- September 30, 2019 – End of the first quarter
- September 30, 2019 – End of Federal Fiscal Year 2018 (FFY18)
- October 1, 2019 – Beginning of Federal Fiscal Year 2019 (FFY19)
- December 31, 2019 – End of the second quarter
- February 11, 2020 – Minnesota Legislature convenes for supplemental budgeting session
- March 31, 2020 – End of the third quarter
- May 18, 2020 – Constitutional Deadline for legislative adjournment, if there are any new competitive grants as a result of this legislative session, we begin work on posting the grant opportunity document to the [Competitive Grant Seeking Page](#).
- June 30, 2020 – End of fiscal year

State Fiscal Year 2021 (SFY21)

SFY21 runs from July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021

- July 1, 2020 – Beginning of fiscal year.
- September 30, 2020 – End of the first quarter
- September 30, 2020 – End of FFY19
- October 1, 2020 – Beginning of Federal Fiscal Year 2020 (FFY20)
- December 31, 2020 – End of second quarter
- Early January 2021 – Legislature convenes for the budgeting session for the State Fiscal Year 2022 and State Fiscal Year 2023.
- March 30, 2021 – End of the third quarter
- May 17, 2021 – Constitutional deadline for legislative adjournment. We will begin work on posting any competitive grants as a result of the legislature's appropriations that will be posted on our [Competitive Grant Seeking Page](#) for state fiscal year 22, which begins July 1, 2021. Any grantee directly named in legislation will be contacted by their specific grants specialist to go over the application process.
- June 30, 2021 – End of the state fiscal year, which is the end of biennium
