# FIND YOUR WAY

ECLDS' COMPREHENSIVE SERVICES MAP HAS BEEN DESIGNED TO WORK AS A GEOLOCATION TOOL FOR MAKING QUICK CONNECTIONS TO RESOURCES IN LOCAL COMMUNITIES. IT CAN ALSO BE USED TO ADVOCATE FOR NEEDED SERVICES NOT YET IN YOUR AREA.

THE MAP ALLOWS YOU TO LOCATE NEARBY SUPPORT PROGRAMS AND RESOURCES THAT CAN BE USEFUL TO THE FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS YOU INTERACT WITH, SUCH AS LOW-COST HEALTH PROVIDERS, EARLY CARE, SCHOOLS, LOCAL AGENCIES, PROGRAMS AND ORGANIZATIONS, CLASSES, AND LIBRARIES.

ADDITIONALLY, YOU MAY FIND THIS TOOL USEFUL FOR GATHERING INFORMATION TO COMPLETE YOUR OWN LOCAL REPORTING AND COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT.



## Adult Basic Education Classes

Accuplacer, adult diploma, career training, citizenship, college prep, computers, English, GED, math, and reading.



## Financial Assistance Programs

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, child care, medical, energy, tax credits, WIC, and community resources.



## School-Related Locations

Colleges/universities, elementary schools, elementary school service areas, and public libraries.



## Early Learning Sites

Classified by star rating, program type (e.g. Head Start, licensed providers, public pre-k), and funding (e.g. CCAP).



## Health-Related Locations

Early childhood mental health grants and low-cost health providers, including doctors, dentists, and others.



## Bus Lines

Only available for counties within the metropolitan area. It includes real-time Metro Transit bus schedules.

# ACCESS STEP BY STEP

Using the map is fairly simple. Go to the left-hand bar to make the appropriate selections for your search and follow these steps:



### Enter Location

Type an address, county, or zip code in the right top, corner of the page.



### Select Services

Some resources require you to select a county from the drop-down menu.



### View Details

Click on icons on the map for details. Go to the table below the map for details.

Zoom in and out as needed. Results will be displayed on a table below the map, which can be exported to a file. A link is provided next to each result for locating a provider on the map. Information on the map is updated once a year.
